Thirty-nine years ago, Clean Ocean Action organized a group of 75 volunteers to remove ankle-deep piles of litter from beaches on Sandy Hook, NJ. From this humble and hopeful beginning, the Beach Sweeps was born. Today, it is the largest grassroots environmental volunteer event in New Jersey, and one of the longest running beach clean ups in the world. Held twice a year (April and October), the Beach Sweeps attract as many as 10,000 volunteers, small and tall, to over 70 waterfront sites and and is a Jersey Shore tradition. The event continues to expand along the Delaware shoreline. Stories shared by volunteers prove Beach Sweeps:

- Inspires team spirit for schools and groups, as well as for the staff and customers of businesses

In fact, the data and statistics were pivotal to our successful campaigns resulting in legislation at the municipal, state, and federal levels. This important work continues, thanks to the Beach Sweeps.
