Clean Ocean Action's Corporate Beach Sweeps program invites corporate partners of all sizes to enjoy a day of purpose at the beach while fostering employee personal growth, fulfillment, and teamwork.

The Corporate Beach Sweeps are adapted from Clean Ocean Action's (COA) signature Beach Sweeps program. These litter removal programs are vital, as litter is harmful to animals who mistake it for food or become entangled in it. Litter also has adverse effects on the state's tourism and coastal economy. By removing debris, volunteers are making NJ's beaches and waterways safer for marine life and more enjoyable for beach-goers.

Employees start the day with an orientation and educational presentation by professional COA staff. This includes an overview of the ecological riches of the national park, current ocean issues, the importance of healthy water quality, the harmful threats of marine debris to marine life, and sources of marine litter to waterways, beaches, and the ocean.

Through a guided hands-on beach cleanup and team building activities employees will remove litter and have immediate satisfaction in transforming and improving the environment and making a difference. Specifically, participants split into groups, collect and remove debris, and record findings—collegially competing to remove trash or find the most unusual item. Crucial to the success, is the tabulation of debris removed. This data along with photos of the day, will be compiled into a personalized report for the company, for bragging rights and sharing. COA will keep records of the data which will be used to support pollution prevention initiatives and legislation. The day wraps up with a de-brief with the employees and COA staff, which includes information on how citizens and businesses can continue to be a positive impact on the environment every day, regardless of where they live, by being better stewards.

In 2022, volunteers from 21 corporations removed an impressive 30,300 pieces of debris at Sandy Hook. Imagine the impact that can be made again this year and the lasting impression employees will have as a result of their purposeful trip to the beach!

Basic Overview Corporate Programs

Corporate Programs run on weekdays from June through mid-September

All programs are held at Sandy Hook, Gateway National Recreation Area in Highlands, NJ

Supports team building with employees while giving back to the ocean and becoming better stewards

Specific cleanup sites on Sandy Hook are selected based on program, group size, and needs

Programs typically run 9am-12:30pm or 1-4 pm

Lunch and event supplies are provided

Please note that transportation is not provided by COA and carpooling is encouraged due to parking limitations. **For groups larger than 50, COA will contact you to discuss transportation recommendations.**

Important Information

COA Cancellation Policy: The event is rain or shine; however, COA will cancel if extreme weather conditions arise (i.e., deluge of rain, thunder and/or lightning, extreme winds, and/or excessive heat, as indicated by the National Weather Service). Keep in mind weather conditions can vary at the shore. If severe weather is anticipated for the day of the sweep, COA staff will contact you at least 48 hours in advance to discuss. In the event of cancellation, COA will provide a list of available dates to reschedule.

Corporate Partner Cancellation: Should your company need to cancel for any other reason, 50% of the billable amount will be charged for cancellation within 5 business days of your cleanup; cancellation in less than 48 hours will be billed at the full amount.

Supplies: COA provides supplies: trash bags, gloves, water, sunscreen, bug spray and first aid kit.

Of Special Note: Sandy Hook is a remote, remarkable, biodiverse ecosystem that is home to a variety of plants (i.e., poison ivy and sumac) and insects (i.e., bees and ticks). **As such, participants with allergies to any insects and/or plants are responsible for bringing and using treatments such as medications or Epi-pens in case of an emergency.**

What to Wear: Appropriate clothing for a beach cleanup, sun protection, & anything else to be prepared for changeable weather conditions (weather along the coast can be different than in urbanized and inland areas). Closed-toed shoes are must.

Other: Corporate partners are encouraged to provide company t-shirts and promotional items such as reusable water bottles for all employees. Please support COA's mission to reduce single-use plastics and limit plastic items at the event.
